Make-up Week

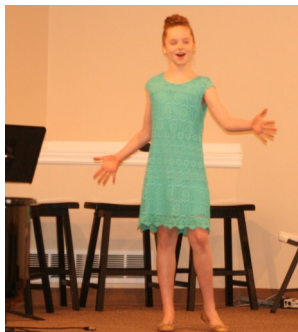

2017-2018 Scholarships



NISOM is now accepting applications for three different scholarships available in the 2017–18 student scholarship program.

1. NISOM offers scholarships for need based financial assistance to students from low and moderate income families and those with demonstrated need. Students of any age are encouraged to apply for lessons, classes, or other programs. Apply by **July 1**.

2. The Flint-Lindsay endowed scholarship fund provides a full scholarship to one current student. The Flint-Lindsay scholarship is based on musicianship as well as financial need. Students with both outstanding musicianship and financial need are strongly encouraged to apply. Those with either outstanding musicianship or financial need will also be considered. Apply by **June 1**.

3. New! A Ryan Scholarship Fund was recently established in memory of Leroy and Marion Ryan. This is a full scholarship for a new NISOM student. Apply by **June 1, 2017**.

Applications for the Flint-Lindsay and for the Ryan scholarships must be accompanied by a letter of recommendation from one of your teachers. Applications and more information are available at nisom.com and in the NISOM office.

Free Student Tickets

A limited number of FREE tickets are available to our ChamberFest Dubuque Gala Concert on June 15. For students in grades 2-12, plus 1-2 adults, up to a \$125 value! These free tickets are intended for students from low and moderate-income families and are provided by a grant from US Bank. Tickets are first-come, first-served. Claim your tickets at the NISOM office.

Each student receives 1 student ticket and up to 2 adult tickets; maximum 4 tickets per household. Students in elementary and middle school must be accompanied by an adult. High school students may be unaccompanied or may receive 1-2 adult tickets. You must plan to use all the free tickets you accept. In the event you are unable to attend, contact NISOM as early as possible, so another student can use them.
